A Note from the Principal:

I can't wait to have our students back to in-person instruction. We miss them dearly at Francisco Elementary School. I was so proud that we had completed the first nine weeks with very few issues and so hopeful. However, following fall break our circumstances changed and forced us once again to complete distance learning (packets) for at least a few weeks. I'm hopeful that we will be able to return after the 2 weeks. As we approach flu season, please remember to monitor your child's temperature and health every morning prior to coming to school. **If your child is exemplifying symptoms, please keep your child home and seek medical attention.** We would appreciate if your child is going to be absent that you call the school to report the absence prior to 9 am and the reason for the absence. We depend on you to help us keep everyone safe and healthy by reporting illness so that we can monitor our school's healthy status very closely.

After meeting with the health department, our fall/winter basketball season will look a little different. This year we will have to limit the number of spectators in our gym at BTS to 200 people. In order to be in compliance with the health departments regulations, we will be doing pre-ticket sales **to all** our home games. Each player will receive 2 complimentary tickets per game. Then we will sale extra tickets to immediate family (those individuals who live in our athlete's household such as siblings), our students, and finally open up sales to extended family and friends. The admission price for both adults and students will be \$2.00 for each game which will be non-refundable. The only individuals that would not need a ticket would be an infant or small child that would sit on the lap of a spectator. The visiting team will also have a limited amount of tickets. Only individuals who have a ticket will be allowed to enter the gym. If we have extra tickets, we will sale them at the door until we reach the maximum of 200. **At that point, individuals will not be allowed to enter.** We will ask that all individuals wear a mask and practice social distancing during basketball season. I know the students are excited and parents and grandparents are ready to watch, but we must be safe if we are going to be allowed to continue to play and for that reason, I am asking your help!

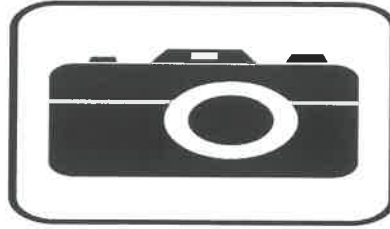
