Applicants must be enrolled in a full-time course of study leading to a two-year degree or certificate at an accredited junior college or State-supported technical college. Applicants must have graduated in the upper half of their high school senior class.	Renewable based on minimum 2.5 GPA
George and Dorothy Eykamp Scholarship (College Scholarship Award)	Applicants must be Gibson County residents or the natural or adopted children of a current employee who has completed the equivalent of one year of full-time service with Mid-States Rubber Products prior to January 31 of the year in which the award is to be made. Applicants must be enrolled in their sophomore year in a full-time course of study leading to a baccalaureate degree at an accredited four-year institution. Applicants must have graduated in the upper third of their high school senior class.	Renewable based on minimum 2.5 GPA
Lois Brink Memorial Nursing Scholarship	Graduates of any Gibson County high school who are enrolled, full- or part-time, as a second-, third-, or fourth-year student in an undergraduate nursing program (RN or BSN). Applicants must be in good standing with the university they are attending.	N/A
R. Dean and Vivian Townsend Memorial Scholarship	Graduating seniors of any Gibson County high school, planning to attend an accredited 2- or 4- year, Indiana public college, university, or trade school. Renewable Scholarship.	2.5
Raymond and Gretchen Cene Memorial Scholarship	Graduating seniors of any Gibson County high school, pursuing a baccalaureate degree at an accredited institution.	3.5
Roy and Dorotha McCarty Scholarship	Graduating high school seniors who have successfully completed coursework and demonstrated outstanding promise in the shop/welding vocational pro-grams of Gibson Southern High School. Applicants must be planning to pursue post-secondary education in voca-tional arts at any accredited college or university.	N/A
1971 WMHS Alumni Scholarship	Graduating seniors of Wood Memorial High School in good academic standing and pursuing post-sec-ondary education at any accredited educational institution. Financial need is not a requirement but may be considered in the selection process.	N/A

Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average (4.0 scale), have been involved in a school-sponsored sport each year of high school , and be regularly involved in community service . Students who have been awarded full "cost of attendance" scholarships as defined by the NCAA are not eligible to apply.	3.0
